Administration

- Business computer systems
- WHS Compliant
- Waste management procedures
- Sufficient insurance cover
- Acceptable Presentation
- Adequate insurance cover (20 million public liability)

Workshop Facilities

- Fibreglass Area
- Aluminium repair area
- Preparation bays
- Wash bay
- Compliant Paint room
- Detail/delivery bay
- Secure Premises

Staff

- Licensed Crane and/or forklift operator
- Estimator
- Foreman/Leading Hand
- Engineering tradesperson (mechanical)
- Panel beaters
- Spray painters
- Workshop manager
- Engineering Tradesperson (Fabrication)

Workshop Equipment

- Fuel Log and Storage
- Parts bins/racks
- Bonnet/Cabin/Sleeper/Axle/Chassis stands
- Cab jig
- Lifting spreader bars
- Floor jacks/Vehicle Jacks/Heavy vehicle
- Forklift and or crane (minimum 4 tonne)
- Spot welder/MIG welder/TIG Welders
- Oxy acetylene LP Gas
- Plasma cutter
- Heat inductor
- Headlight focusing equipment

- Parts cleaner
- Portable trestles
- Hydraulic Press
- Slings/chains/ropes (tested and tagged)
- Steam cleaner
- Heavy vehicle hoist or inspection pit or a method to allow under vehicle inspection and repairs
- Riveting tools

<u>Paint:</u>

- Compliant baking oven (minimum 17m long by 5m wide by 5m high)
- Air feed spray hoods
- Portable dust extraction
- Colour dialling and spray out cards
- Gun wash
- HVLP Spray Guns or equivalent

<u>Chassis</u>

- Approved heavy vehicle chassis alignment and straightening equipment
- Chassis aligning equipment
- Porta Power Ram Set (minimum 1 x 20 tonne)
