Lodging Nominations

Nominations open on 19/02/2021 and must reach the Returning Officer, Ishtiaq Ahmed not later than 12:00pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 05/03/2021.

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 19/03/2021.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to lEBnominations@aec.gov.au PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
- 2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may lodge a written statement signed by him not exceeding 200 words in length setting out such information in relation to his candidature as he may consider relevant thereto and as the Returning Officer may in his absolute discretion approve for distribution to voters." Statements should be emailed as a word document to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00pm (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 12/03/2021 can be accepted.

Scrutineer Appointment

The appointment of the scrutineer must be notified in writing to the Returning Officer within 48 hours before the ballot closing time. The appointed scrutineer is required to be a member or affiliate member or a Life Member or a nominated representative.
